Commissioner Pct. 1, Eddilisa Ray and Commissioner Pct. 3, Jimmy Long were not present for this meeting.

The Regular Session was called to order at 10:00 AM.

There were no registrations for public comment at this meeting.

The Court recognized Bergan Pinkley, Big Spring High School's Outstanding Female Student, who was unable to attend the May 11th meeting. 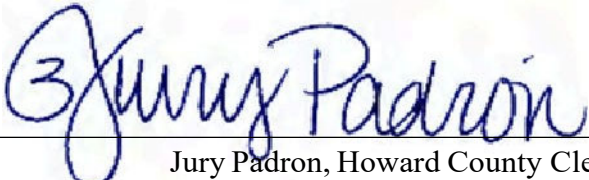
