

BE IT REMEMBERED that on Monday, July 13, 2026, the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in Workshop Session at 9:00 AM and in Regular Session at 10:00 AM with RANDY JOHNSON, County Judge, as the Presiding Officer. The following members were present: Commissioner Pct. 3, Jimmy Long; Commissioner Pct. 4, Doug Wagner and County Judge, Randy Johnson. Commissioner Pct. 1, Eddilisa Ray and Commissioner Pct. 2, Cash Berry, were not present for this meeting.

Judge Johnson Opened in Prayer and Called the Meeting to Order at 9:00 AM.

The Commissioners' Court held its annual meetings for organizations receiving County financial contributions exceeding \$6,000. Representatives provided updates regarding their respective funding allocations, expenditures, and the overall utilization of Howard County donations. Presenters included: Kris Dokey, Board President for the Howard County Volunteer Fire Department; Chavonna Parker and Lynn Creswell, Advocates representing Victim Services of Big Spring and Rodney Jones, CEO and Jessie Campbell, CFO, representing West Texas Centers This was a discussion item and no formal action was taken by the court.

Court Recessed at 9:55 AM and Reconvened in Regular Session at 10:01 AM.

Judge Johnson led the opening pledges and provided the court with a recap of the preceding workshop session.

There were no registrations for public comment at this meeting.
